- (3) Out of the total four project companies owning respective solar power plants with the aggregate installed capacity of 195MW, the Group has completed the acquisition of two project companies owning respective solar power plants with aggregate installed capacity of 90MW and is in the process of completing the acquisition of the remaining two project companies owning the respective solar power plants with an aggregate installed capacity of 105MW.
- (4) The figures provided herein are subject to rounding adjustment.
