SUMMARY OF ELECTRICITY GENERATION VOLUME OF POWER PLANTS FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2020

This announcement is made by Beijing Energy International Holding Co., Ltd. (the “**Company**”, collectively with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group. The board of directors of the Company announces that according to the Group’s preliminary operation statistics, the 61 power plants beneficially owned by the Group have generated electricity in an aggregate volume of approximately 644,070 megawatt-hour (“**MWh**”) in the fourth quarter (“**Q4**”) of 2020, and the aggregate electricity generation volume for the twelve months ended 31 December 2020 has amounted to approximately 2,756,702 MWh.

Details of the electricity generation statistics in Q4 of 2020 are summarised as below:
