SUMMARY OF ELECTRICITY GENERATION VOLUME OF POWER PLANTS FOR THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2021

This announcement is made by Beijing Energy International Holding Co., Ltd. (the “**Company**”, collectively with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group. The board of directors of the Company announces that according to the Group’s preliminary operation statistics, the 77 power plants beneficially owned by the Group have generated electricity in an aggregate volume of approximately 1,124,111 megawatt-hours (“**MWh**”) in the third quarter (“**Q3**”) of 2021, and the aggregate electricity generation volume for the nine months ended 30 September 2021 has amounted to approximately 2,869,057 MWh.

Details of the electricity generation statistics in Q3 of 2021 are summarised as below:
