## **SUMMARY OF ELECTRICITY GENERATION VOLUME OF POWER PLANTS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2026**

This announcement is made by Beijing Energy International Holding Co., Ltd. (the “**Company**”, collectively with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group. The board of directors of the Company announces that according to the Group’s preliminary operation statistics, the 271 power plants beneficially owned by the Group and its associates have generated electricity in an aggregate volume of approximately 6,279,806 megawatt-hours (“**MWh**”) in the first quarter (“**Q1**”) of 2026.

Details of the electricity generation volume statistics in Q1 of 2026 are summarised as below:

*Notes:*

- (1) Certain power plants of the Group further increased the grid-connected installed capacity of approximately 104MW in total in Q1 of 2026.
- (2) The Group completed the self-construction of one wind power plant, one storage power station and one gas-fired power plant, which achieved a total grid-connected installed capacity of approximately 297MW in Q1 of 2026.
- (3) The Group completed an acquisition of one solar power plant in Q1 of 2026, which achieved grid-connected installed capacity of approximately 294MW.
- (4) By the end of December 2025, certain power plants of the Group ceased to be consolidated as subsidiaries, but were reclassified as associates of the Company. Therefore, the comparative amounts of electricity generation volume for the period ended 31 March 2025 from these power plants were reclassified from “Power plants held by the subsidiaries of the Company” to “Power plants held by the associates of the Company” to conform to the current quarter presentation accordingly as if the deconsolidation had taken effect on 1 January 2025.
- (5) The operation figures previously announced have been adjusted to be in line with the available accounting figures and to reflect the changes in our portfolio of power plants with effect from the respective completion date of each transaction.
- (6) The figures provided herein are subject to rounding adjustment and will also be subject to other possible adjustments due to accounting procedures.

Shareholders and/or potential investors of the Company are hereby reminded that the information provided above merely represents the preliminary operating performance of the renewable energy power plants beneficially owned by the Group and its associates as of 31 March 2026 based on data currently available to the management, and is by no means a representation or a basis of reference or indication of the revenue or profit to be generated or derived by the Group or any financial performance of the Group in Q1 of 2026 or for the three months ended 31 March 2026.
